Community Service Scholarship

Kiwaniis International is a worldwide organization consisting of local clubs dedicated to service and the youth in their communities and beyond. The Kiwanis Club of Shelley's mission includes supporting the young people of Shelley and Firth to be actively engaged in service to their communities. In recognition of this focus, the Kiwanis Club of Shelley offers an annual scholarship to students in the Shelley and Firth School Districts. Traditionally, a student at each school has received a scholarship of \$300-\$500; however, the scholarship is not limited to two students, and additional scholarships may be awarded depending on available scholarship funds and the strength of the scholarship applications.

The Kiwanis Club of Shelley Community Service Scholarship is a single monetary award to be applied to the cost of tuition, books, and/or lab fees to the scholarship recipient's choice of accredited college, university, or technical school in the United States as a full-time student. Funds can be held if the student is planning a gap year or service opportunity before enrollment.

APPLICATION REQUIREMENTS:

- Must be graduating this year from Shelley or Firth High School.
- Minimum GPA 3.0
- Must submit the following documents to your counselor:
 1. **Completed Application**
 2. **Essay**-minimum of 500 words, typed, with applicant's full name at the top of each page.
Subject: Describe your service contributions and involvement in your community during your high school years with an emphasis on the current school year. Please indicate how at least one specific project or service you organized or participated in, impacted your community. Share how it originated, and who received benefit.
 3. **Letters of Recommendation** – Submit two letters of recommendation from adults, other than your family, who are familiar with your service experiences.
 4. **Transcript**-from your counselor's office
- **Application Deadline: Friday, April 1, 2022.** Turn in applications and required documents to Firth High School or Shelley High School Counselor Offices.
- **Scholarship Recipient Responsibilities:** In order to properly award funds, recipients must contact us at kiwanisclubofshelley@gmail.com or, **PO box 461, Shelley, ID 83274**. Communication must include your name, high school, graduation year, name of the accredited college, university, or technical school in the United States that you have been accepted to, their mailing address, your Student ID, verification of registration and start date.
